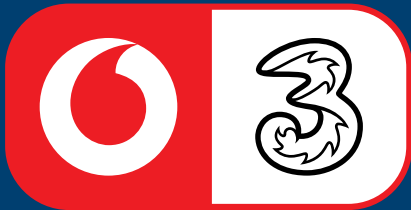
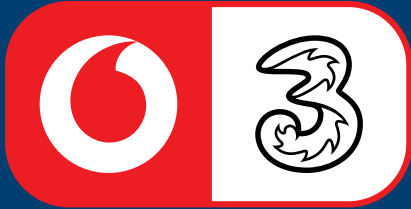

VodafoneThree UK Business transforms safety management with HSI

VodafoneThree UK Business supports some of the UK's largest enterprise customers with their telecommunications requirements. Behind these services is a network of engineers operating across diverse environments, supported by a dedicated Health & Safety team focused on protecting workers, maintaining compliance, and meeting increasingly demanding customer expectations.

As the organisation continued to grow, its existing safety processes became increasingly difficult to manage. Seeking a more scalable and connected approach, VodafoneThree UK Business selected HSI HandsHQ RAMS and HSI Donesafe to modernise risk management, improve governance, and support a stronger safety culture across its operations.

Challenge

Managing risk assessments, method statements, and wider safety processes across a growing business had become increasingly complex.

Although established processes were in place, they relied heavily on a combination of Word documents, spreadsheets, Microsoft Teams, and manual administration. Maintaining RAMS templates, managing version control, controlling access permissions, and ensuring consistency across the organisation required significant ongoing effort.

As customer expectations evolved and safety culture became a greater priority, the Health & Safety team recognised that existing processes would become increasingly difficult to scale.

Need

VodafoneThree UK Business knew it needed more than a digital version of its existing processes. The organisation wanted to improve consistency, strengthen governance, reduce administrative effort, and create a more proactive approach to safety management.

The goal was to establish a scalable framework capable of supporting future growth while improving visibility and control across safety activities.

Solution: HSI HandsHQ RAMS + HSI Donesafe

VodafoneThree UK Business selected both HSI HandsHQ RAMS and HSI Donesafe to create a connected approach to safety management.

With HSI HandsHQ RAMS, VodafoneThree UK Business standardised the creation, review, and governance of risk assessments and method statements. The platform introduced a structured, digital framework for managing RAMS, reducing reliance on manual processes while improving consistency, strengthening version control, and increasing visibility across teams and sites.

HSI Donesafe complements this by supporting permit-to-work, contractor management, and wider safety processes within a single system. By digitising workflows and bringing critical safety data together, HSI Donesafe improves oversight of high-risk activities, enhances coordination across teams, and helps strengthen governance while reducing the administrative burden associated with manual processes.
